Subject: Compliance of the provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 - regarding

Teaching/Non-teaching,

You are aware that NCTE has notified National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition Norms and Procedures) Regulations, 2014 vide Notification No. 346 dated 01.12.2014. The Regulations have come into force with effect from the date of publication in the Gazette of India and with the publication of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 the Regulations of 2009 stand repealed. The New Regulations are applicable in respect of both existing Teacher Education Institutions and the new institutions intending to offer Teacher Education Programme(s). The Regulations have introduced some new provisions and have modified some of the provisions in the Regulations which were in force since 2009. The existing Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) shall have to initiate the process of compliance in respect of the New Regulation Norms and Standards for various Teacher Education Programmes.

As per the Guidelines issued by the NCTE Hqrs. No. F.51-4/2014/NCTE/N&S dated 24.12.2014 before submitting the affidavit, the institution shall ensure that all the requirements as per the provisions of NCTE Regulations, 2014 shall be complied before 31st October, 2015. An Explanatory Note on implications of the New Regulations for the existing Teacher Education Institutions alongwith the decision of the NRC taken in this regard in the 231st meeting as per minutes are uploaded on the NRC website www.nrcncte.org for your reference.

Therefore, you are advised to take necessary action at the earliest and intimate the same to the undersigned within 21 days from the date of receipt of this letter along with the affidavit in the prescribed format (uploaded in the NRC website www.nrcncte.org), failing which the revised order of recognition will not be issued and the recognition granted earlier will become invalid. Copy of the recognition order issued by the NRC, NCTE shall also be sent by existing Teacher Education Institutions with the Affidavit.
